## **School Notices:**

**Industrial Action** is planned to take place across the country on 2 dates, next week: **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July**. This action is in light of the ongoing dispute with the government over working conditions and unfunded pay offers.
