- 20mph lights: I am happy to say that, after years of hoping and asking, things are finally progressing with the School 20 When Lights Show programme. Somerset CC Traffic Management Team will be deploying flashing lights at school during both drop-off and pick-up. This is very welcome news because, as you will know, our school road is currently national speed limit!
- Warm clothing: we are trying to conduct as much PE and games outside,

currently. Every class is maintaining a balance of physical activity and using their 2 hours a week minimum. This is on the school playground as much as possible to help with safe and positive practices. Please ensure your child has something warm to wear outside, such as a hoodie or track suit bottoms.

• <u>Safe around the village:</u> Our PCSO will be visiting Monday to discuss our 20mph as well as traffic flow around the school. Our staggered times have led to real success at getting to and away from school in great timing and our roads are now quiet by 3:38 every day, which is remarkable when compared to pre-pandemic! During the busy times – 3 to 3:30pm – please do *try* and maintain the flow of traffic in the same direction. It works so well when the vast majority of cars go down the hill and through the village, slowly. As always, I hugely appreciate your efforts with this.
