Isabella told me that there were many more there than last time (133 finishers!) but they all did incredibly well. Considering that Jack is a Year 3 pupil, to get in the top 40 of a race, open to pupils up to and including 11 year olds, is outstanding! I am very proud of all 3 pupils and look forward to seeing how they do at the next one in March.
- We took a decision to hold our own pentathlon event in school for all years 5 and 6 and remotely input our results to Somerset Activity and Sports Partnership (SASP) Standing long jump, speed bounce, chest push, vertical jump and shuttle runs were all measured out accurately and recorded by Mr Webb and Mr Gunstone. Some of the results were excellent, reflecting the talent of our pupils in Years 5 and 6. Evie in Year 6 has reached a 'gold' level, which I believe, has not been reached in school for approximately 4 years! When we have the results in from all schools, we will let you know how we did.
